The **Kechnie Benefits Model Portfolios** are a series of professionally managed investment portfolios designed to suit five types of investors:

- ➤ **Growth Investor:** looks for long-term growth. They have a high risk tolerance and invest primarily in the stock markets but maintain a position in income securities.
- ➤ Aggressive Growth Investor: cultivates the best possible long-term growth by investing their capital in equity. They are willing to accept major portfolio fluctuations in the short-term.

As you can see, each type of investor has a unique investment goal and tolerance for risk. Our portfolios are tailored to meet these needs.

We also offer MARI (Method for Automatic Rebalancing of Investments) in each Kechnie Benefits Model Portfolio. Over time stock markets fluctuate and it's likely that a portfolio asset allocation will deviate from its original mix. Should any position in a Kechnie Benefits Model Portfolio gain by 5%, mutual fund units will be sold to shift the portfolio back to its original investment mix. In this way your portfolio will always reflect your goals.
